

## **GS-550E./GS-550ES.**

The choice for the hottest, most sophisticated middleweight sports bike on the street has just been narrowed down to two: the brand new GS-550E and 550ES.

At a glance, their racing heritage is obvious. The super-light, super-strong box-section tubing frame cradles an allnew engine: a high-compression, highoutput 16-valve TSCC powerplant designed to accelerate like a GP machine. A totally new pair of responsive twobarrel CV carburetors meter the fuel, without the added weight or complexity of four carbs. Transistorized electronic ignition provides a precisely controlled spark. A high-performance oil cooler

enhances reliability. A power-efficient black chromed exhaust system is tucked close to the frame for maximum banking clearance. Combined, it all adds up to a rush of acceleration that's unmatched in the Middleweight Class.

And both new 550s have nimble handling to match the engine's rapid response: A race-bred 16-inch mag-type

front wheel and low-profile tubeless tire provide precise steering response and unmatched braking performance... without the excessive weight and gyroscopic effect of larger-diameter designs. The air forks provide a balance of comfort, control and steadiness that must be felt to be appreciated. And Suzuki's integral Anti-dive system works in con-



junction with a pair of powerful slotted front discs and a single rear disc to provide quick, stable stops.

At the rear, each of these high-performance canyon carvers has the most sophisticated suspension going: Suzuki's Full Floater system, which utilizes a single shock and a remote hydraulic pre-load adjuster. With it, the machine

responds with accurate, controlled cornering and uncanny stability and comfort. And while we've clearly cornered the

And while we've clearly cornered the performance end of the middleweight market, there's considerably more to sport riding than speed and handling alone. Both new GS-550's also have the kind of style that sets them apart from the rest: The 550E's quarter fairing provides

great looks, while the GS-550ES's frame mounted half fairing is the maximum in functional, race-inspired style. It's a style that both bikes share, with high-capacity fuel tanks, integrated side panels and sleek tail sections. Plus, there are added touches like the Euro-style fenders, contoured saddles and aluminum muffler brackets with rearset controls.

For maximum middleweight performance, experience the new GS-550E or 550Es. At less than 430 lbs. each, they're packed with all the excitement of GP racebikes, yet possess all the features and sophistication of our larger road machines. And that's the Sensation of Suzuki.
